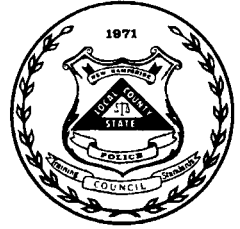

Subcommittee members met in classroom one directly after the regular PSTC meeting.

Chief Morency called the meeting to order at 10:40 a.m.

The subcommittee meeting began with members talking about the number of applications or resumes received, and the electronic format of the documents.

Motion by Attorney General MacDonald, seconded by Colonel Wagner to begin a non public session citing RSA 91-A:3, II(b) The hiring of any person as a public employee. The roll call vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

At 10:45 the Subcommittee began a nonpublic session.

Motion to exit the nonpublic session by Attorney General MacDonald, seconded by Colonel Wagner, the roll call vote was unanimous.

At 11:25 a.m. the council returned to public session.


