At 9:35 Vice Chairman, Chief Morency called the meeting to order.

Chief Morency asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the November 19, 2019 subcommittee meeting.

Motion by Sheriff Valerino, seconded by Attorney General MacDonald to accept the minutes from the meeting of the subcommittee on November 19, 2019, the subcommittee vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

Motion by Attorney MacDonald, seconded by Commissioner Hanks, to initiate a nonpublic session citing RSA 91-A:3, II(b) The hiring of any person as a public employee. The roll call vote was unanimous in favor of the motion

At 9:39 a.m. the subcommittee began a nonpublic session.

Motion to exit the nonpublic session by Attorney General MacDonald, seconded by Chief Cormier, the roll call vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

At 10:10 a.m. the subcommittee was back in public session.



The roll call vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

The next step will be to present the four names that were narrowed down from the group of applications to the Council on December 17, 2019 meeting. The subcommittee will inquire about what the Council would prefer for an interview panel. The goal is to have a candidate to present to the Council at the January 28, 2020 meeting. The tentative interview date will be on January 7, 2020.
