- 2. Acceptance of Public Meeting Minutes: A motion was made to accept the May 1, 2023, minutes by Director Scippa and seconded by Chief Ace. The motion passed unanimously.
- 3. Review of Standards Manual (Chapters 1-12): The Commission review, discussed and revised Chapters 1-12. Once the manual has been updated with these revisions, the manual will be forward to Attorney General Formella for a final review.
- 4. Old Business Updates: The Commission recognized the hard work of those on the subcommittee who worked on the submission of the Three Hundred Thousand Department of Justice Grant. The hope is that grant will ensure the continued operation of the program. Chief King reported that over 100 people came to presentation at the NNEPAC conference and there is a lot of questions and excitement for the program. Questions remain what the bridge program would cost for PowerDMS for those that are currently Nationally Accredited and have currently have the software. There was also discussion and agreement that the standards would be available for downloading once approved and eventually posted on the website.
- <u>New Business:</u> Chief King spoke about the possibility of the creation of separate website for the program that is more dynamic and user friendly then what is allowed through Department of Information Technology. A motion was made by Director Scippa and seconded by Chief Ace to for the Commission to Establish a new website. A rollcall vote was cast, and the motion passed unanimously. After receiving guidance from Attorney Moeser on the proper procedure needed a Request for Proposal, a motion was made by Chief Chase and seconded by Senior AAG Broadhead to create RFP for the website. A rollcall vote was cast, and motion passed unanimously.
- **<u>6.</u> Public Input:** Chief Ferland again thanked the Commission for it's work and asked about the process for the auditors. The Commission will be focusing on many of the administrative and operational questions once the standard has been approved.
