- Acceptance of Public Meeting Minutes: A motion was made to accept the May 22, 2023, minutes by Chief Hoebeke; seconded by Director Scippa. The motion passed unanimously.
- 3. Review of Final Revisions to Draft Manual: The Commission reviewed and discussed the final draft of the manual. A motion was made to approve the final draft, as written, by Representative Roy and seconded by Director Scippa. The motion passed unanimously. The standards will be transmitted to PowerDMS for upload into the accreditation software and prepared by PSTC/DoIT for posting on the program website. Future material revisions will be submitted to the Commission for consideration.
- 4. Program Manager Update: After much discussion, the Commission agreed that the previously approved start-up date of the program will be July 3, 2023. Program Manager French is in the process of completing a "process manual" for participating agencies and will email his completed draft to the Commission for review and input prior to the next scheduled Commission meeting (June 26, 2023). The Commission also discussed the need for a program timeline following the July 3rd start-up. Issues to be addressed include the assessor application process, assessor training and compensation, assessment checklists and assessor job description. Director Scippa will be seeking a meeting with DOP Director Lorrie Rudis in order to discuss the hiring process of assessors for the program. Information about this process will be discussed further at the June 26th meeting.
- **5.** Old Business: The Commission website development request for proposal (RFP) has not been released yet. An update will be provided at the next scheduled meeting.
- **6.** <u>Public Comment:</u> Chief Ferland once again thanked the Commission for its work. He expressed an interest in obtaining a copy of the Accreditation Standards as soon as possible as he is in contact with several agencies that are reluctant to commit to the process without first seeing the standards.
