- 3. <u>PowerDMS/Powerstandards Presentation:</u> Jared Goldberg provided a brief introduction and demonstration of PowerDMS. Once an application has been approved by the Commission, the applying agency will be emailed a link by PowerDMS. PowerDMS will then invoice the applying agency and provide them with an introductory orientation session.
- **4. PSTC Update:** The standards manual has been posted on the website. The MOU extension has been filed and there was extensive discussion on how accessors will be employed and compensated to ensure compliance with labor laws and retirement restrictions.
- 5. Program Manager Update: Chief French provided updates on the edits to the Process Manual. This will be reviewed further prior to being voted on. Chief French updated the Commission on the AccredNET meeting and the discussion on the new standards from the United States Department of Justice. The Commission discussed whether all these standards should be included in the NH Accreditation process. The topic was tabled. Chief French was also advised to forward the AccredNET membership dues to Director Scippa. There was discussion on what is a public document during the accreditation process, culminating in a final report completed by the program manager for presentation to the Commission for each accreditation decision.
