**<u>1.</u>** <u>**Roll Call:**</u> At 12:00pm Committee Chairman Chief (ret.) Ace called the meeting to order.

- <u>Acceptance of Previous Public Minutes</u>: Motion by Sheriff Rivera seconded by Dr. Czarnec to approve the February 06, 2024, meeting minutes. A rollcall vote was cast, and the motion passed unanimously.
- 3. <u>"Sworn" vs. "Unsworn" Personnel:</u> The subcommittee discussed the need to further define the definition of "sworn personnel" vs. "sworn law enforcement/police personnel" as it relates to adherence to accreditation standards. The subcommittee will recommend to the Commission the term "sworn" to refer to sworn law enforcement officers/deputies certified by the New Hampshire Police Standards and Training Council. Sworn personnel/deputies not meeting this criterion shall be treated, for accreditation purposes as civilian personnel.
- <u>4.</u> <u>Compliance with DOJ Standards</u>: The subcommittee discussed the need to ensure that the New Hampshire Law Enforcement Accreditation Standards include the 20 mandatory standards outlined in the Department of Justice National Standards for Independent Credentialing Bodies. The subcommittee will recommend to the Commission modifications to standards 3.3.2 Annual Evaluations, 3.3.3 Employee Consultation, and 3.3.4 Recruitment Plan. Specifically:

3.3.2 Annual Evaluations: Using the state requirements, add "officers or deputies in assessment of adherence to the agency policies shall be addressed."

3.3.4 Recruitment Plan: Add the sentence, "A desired goal will be to recruit persons who live in or are from the community being served."
