1. Roll Call: At 12:00pm Committee Chairman Chief (ret.) Ace called the meeting to order.

- 2. Acceptance of Previous Public Minutes: Motion by Sheriff Rivera seconded by Chief (ret). Ace to approve the January 08, 2024, meeting minutes. A rollcall vote was cast, and the motion passed unanimously.
- 3. Creation of a Standard: The subcommittee discussed developing a new standard requiring the recording of custodial interrogations, as proposed by pending bill Senate Bill 80. The Senate Judiciary Committee has voted to refer the bill to interim study, allowing for it to be worked on in 2024, with the expectation of a new bill in 2025. The subcommittee will continue to monitor the progress of Senate Bill 80 as it moves through the Senate. The subcommittee will also work on creating a new standard addressing this issue.
- 4. The subcommittee discussed the need to further define the definition of "sworn personnel" vs. "sworn law enforcement/police personnel" as it relates to adherence to accreditation standards.
- 5. The subcommittee discussed the need to ensure that the New Hampshire Law Enforcement Accreditation Standards include the 20 mandatory standards outlined in the Department of Justice
